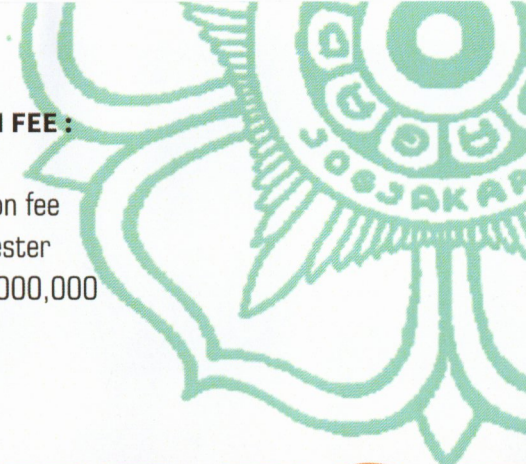

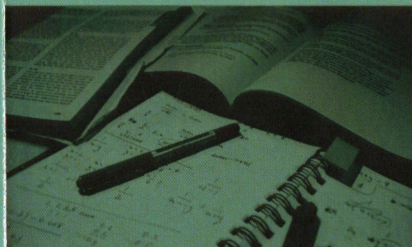

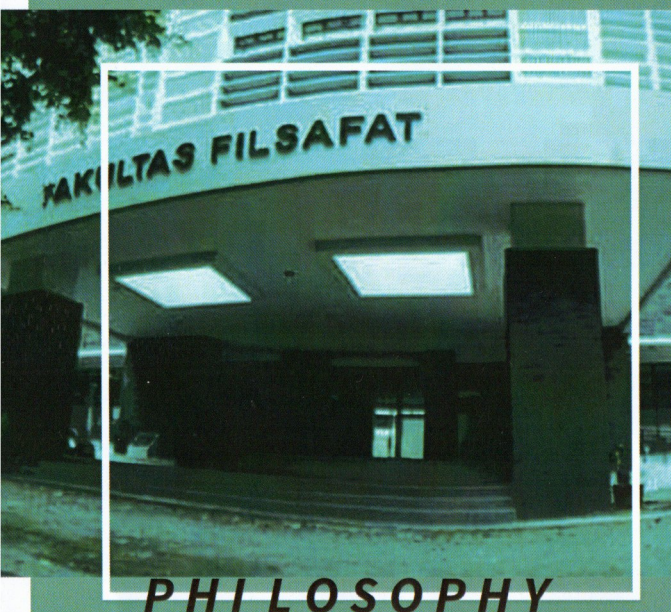

EDUCATION AND LEARNING PROGRAM

The Philosophy Master Program organizes education and teaching in which students are obligated to take 49 credits. The number of credits consists of 19 compulsory subjects, 12 credits of thesis, 12 compulsory subjects of study interest and 6 credits of free choice courses.

The learning process is carried out through: lectures, discussions, seminars, thesis proposal presentations, thesis research, and thesis research results presentations. The duration of study is 6 semester maximum.

PHILOSOPHY MASTER PROGRAM

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS

1 Graduated with bachelor's degree from various disciplines from state or private universities, from within and outside the country that has been accredited by BAN-PT.

Have a grade point average grade point average (GPA) of bachelor's degree:

a. More than or equal to 2.50 (scale 4) for graduates of study programs accredited A.

b. More than or equal to 2.75 (scale 4) for graduates of study programs accredited B.

c. More than or equal to 3.00 (scale 4) for graduates of study programs accredited C.

3 Having an Academic Potential Test (TPA) score of more than or equal to 450 as evidenced by a valid certificate, a maximum of 2 years after the date of issuance of the certificate.

4 Having a Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score of more than or equal to 400, proven by a valid certificate.

5 Applicants who have not met one or both of the requirements for the TPA and TOEFL scores are required to sign and attach a statement to fulfill these requirements within a maximum of 3 months at the beginning of the study period.
